

YOUNG AUTHOR ATTACKS ADVANCING POLICE STATE

In the 50's, in Philly; the police would harass any Black caught downtown after dark; in the 60's the world watched as super pig Frank Rizzo's cops stripped some Black Panthers naked in the streets; in the 70's they intimidated and set up progressive forces with the FBI as Hoover's Counter Intelligence Program (Cointelpro) legitimized our oppression; in the 80's the barbarians in blue bombed a houseful of Black children, women and men killing eleven, now here in the 90's armed Black men are shot down for being Black men as we kiss the 20th century goodbye.

It is not progress. No, it's the Advancing Police State. So-called Civil Rights gains, legislation and Black Power movements have yet to stop the Advancing Police State. Yes, these are strange times. For the first time in our-story here, we are ideologically traveling backward. It seems as if Amerikkka's drug distractions of; deadly legal and illegal substances, religious intoxication, toys, greed, sexual backwardness, instant millionaire fever, perceived pitiful powerlessness, lazy leisure lunacy and rampant individualism has caught up with us.

We have become imitations of our former masters willingly hoping we won't have to confront these people. At the same time, we bury our heads in the sand hoping we won't be destroyed or expelled from their country. Even though they have been ethnic cleansing for centuries.

These are things they are historically proud of. But check it, they are too ignorant to peep their own victimization and that Amerikkka's future don't include most of them. In addition, any contradictions between whites helps delay them collectivity vamping on our asses.

In the wake of the burning of Black religious temples (churches), the continuation of lynchings, the poisoning of our people, the miseducation of more than Lauryn Hill, economic exploitation of the 'hood and its residents, their mass media total anti-Afrikan propaganda attack, it is the "Advancing Police State" that is putting barbed wire around us all.

The information is everywhere. From the little struggle centers encased in

true Black Book Stores, information is floating in the Black corridors on the internet, and for those who know our basic interest from their's can even read their products and understand their racist intent.

But their acceleration of their physical hold on us in the streets speaks volumes about their evil solution to their perceived race problem. In New York alone the police have even risen above their own racist record of cruelty, brutality and "official murder." Examples jump to mind as the screams of the Haitian Brother in a New York Police Station bathroom echoes through the universe as he is assaulted by police officers as a wooden handle is jammed up his rectum bursting vital organs and tearing tissue.

Can you not feel terror experienced by Eleanor Bumpus as they ended her brutalization with a hail of life stealing bullets? The Black Community screamed no more. Now recently, our Brother from Guinea, Amadou Diallo, was killed by New York Police in a hail of 41 bullets which riddled his body and took him out. All were unarmed, all Blacks from the Caribbean, Afrika and the United Snakes.

They were all buried with tears and shouts of "No More!" Yet the dying continues, because Black Death is police policy as the murderous siege continues throughout this nation and globally. Just review the police records in your own community and it will reveal that instances of police abuse is growing unchecked.

In this environment, Max Rameau uses this book to reveal the goals and objectives of the national and international Police States. This important book puts the situation in focus as the strategy, tactics, objectives and methodology of the police state are exposed like any dangerous live wires.

I personally seen and experienced enough police brutality to understand clearly the roll of the police (Amerikkka's first line of defense and shock troops). I witnessed all governmental agencies in the city of Philadelphia conspire to murder men, women and children of the Family Move with Black politicians leading the charge.

We watched out numbered and under total unannounced Marshall Law the mass murderers of community folks marked for extermination. They used

water as a weapon; firemen as attack dogs, the Red Cross as their personal welcome to the 'Hood wagons, an air force with a bomb droppin' helicopter and ambulances and medics for their folk who got tired or overwhelmed by the smell of burnin' Black flesh. Later, silent coroners carts were used to pick up pieces of blown apart flesh of our people.

The police took over homes and buildings sweeping the people out like so much trash, they set up high command post in high rise building and copped their dangerous explosives from their FBI cronies.

There is no way I can tell you what that overwhelming police terror looked like or felt like in the neighborhood I grew up in. After they dropped a bomb on the houseful of defenseless human beings, they surrounded the city block and let it burn out of control.

Children attempting to escape the heat of the deadly blaze were shot by snipers and thrown back into the fire. To this day, after years of investigation they can not explain why their sharp shooters had silencers on their weapons. Silencers are tools of assassins.

Read this book carefully, learn and prepare. A police State is not just an instrument of control, but also one of genocide. Nah, we don't have to understand Grenada, Haiti or Somalia to understand the barbarism in which the enemy is capable. And no, we can't just wish them away. This book was designed to increase our chances of progress and survival.

From Pig Frank Rizzo up South Philly, to Pig Bull Conner down south, and don't forget gutless Gates formerly of Los Angeles, our story is littered with over zealous barbarians brutalizing our people.

Rameau is taking us into new turf as the national, state and local governments are conspiring to set us up, and contain us as they prepare us for the final phase of the Black Holocaust.

On the books, they have the King Alfred Plan that was revamped into Rex '84 by dangerous Oliver North, who was commissioned by Ronald Reagan. Using Executive Orders, the president of this country can declare open season on our people and suspend all of our so-called constitutional rights.

The author is issuing a critical warning, one that we must take serious. Even those who doubt the information will be moved to investigate reality. It's his perspective and ideology that helps clarify the madness. Beyond slogans and marching, we have done little to prepare for the future shock of increased destabilization, nullification and extermination.
