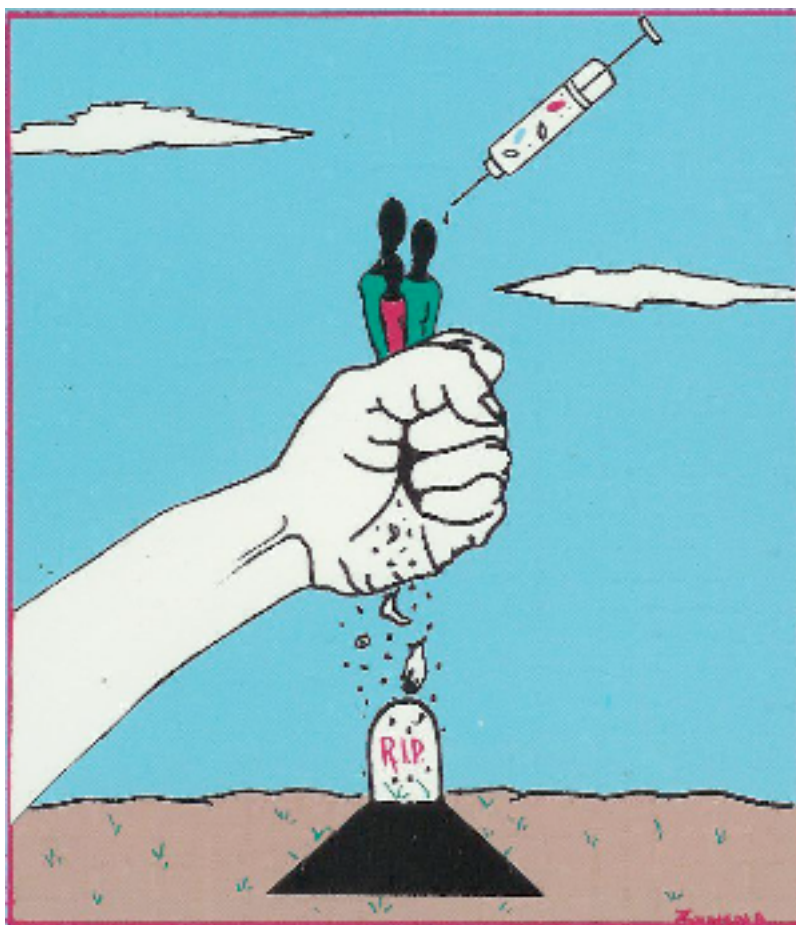


# U.S. Population Control Continues to Kill

A U.S.-sponsored program that resulted in the sterilization of nearly half of Brazil's women has prompted a formal congressional inquiry, sponsored by more than 165 legislators from every political party that is represented in the Brazilian legislature. The investigation was initiated after information about a secret U.S. National Security Council memorandum on American population control objectives in developing countries was published in the Journal de Brasilia, Hova do Povo (Rio de Janeiro), Journal do Brasil, and other major newspapers in early May.

The charge: millions sterilized to meet U.S. political objectives

It seems the world is now alarmed and catching up with genocidal efforts of the New World Order's (NWO) white supremacist plans to decrease the population of people of color on this planet. As author of the books "Black Holocaust: Global Genocide" and "Black Holocaust 2000" I have been writing on the genocidal component of the barbaric Globalists who are scheming to control the earth for another millennium. Now the people of the Americas and beyond are concerned at the targets on their asses. Baobab Press --Vol.1 Number 12 goes on:

*That U.S. foreign policy document, officially known as National Security Study Memorandum 200 or NSSM 200, detailed a plan to target thirteen large developing nations with intensive efforts to promote population "policies" that would allow the U.S. to run massive birth control and*

*sterilization projects in those countries. Brazil, the study said, was placed on the list of thirteen target nations because it “clearly dominates the continent [South America] demographically,” and its population was projected to equal that of the United States by the turn of the century.*

A 1974 report from the National Security Council (NSC), the CIA, the Department of State and Defense (DOD) and USAID pointed out the growing status of Brazil in Latin America and on the world scene. NSC named other targets for depopulation and those are: Nigeria, Egypt, Ethiopia, Pakistan, Indonesia, Turkey, Bangladesh, India, Thailand, the Philippines, Mexico and Colombia. It was formerly a classified document and it was approved as part of American foreign policy in '75 by Brent Scowcroft, who served as then-President Gerald Ford's security advisor. He occupies the same office today under George W. Bush. All over Latin America this policy is now being discussed as the people are made aware.

*Brazil's Ministry of Health, which had begun an investigation into the sterilization program even before the American population strategy documents were disclosed, has revealed that 44 percent of all Brazilian women between the ages of 14 and 55 have been permanently sterilized. The older women apparently had the operation done when the program started, nearly two decades ago. News reports charge that many of these women underwent the operation without their knowledge or consent.*

According to some reports, as many as 90 percent of all Brazilian women of Afrikan descent have been sterilized. If this is true, the Afrikan population in Brazil will soon be wiped out. Currently, that population is second in size to Nigeria. Did you know that at least half of Brazil's 154 million people are Black?

The sterilization program in Brazil, like those just now beginning in dozens of Afrikan nations, started as a relatively small, “voluntary” family planning campaign. Neocolonialism's oppression and exploitation create the condition where the indigenous population starves as the small underdeveloped nation is raped of its natural resources and labor. Planned parenthood models used were founded by former Nazi sympathizer Margaret Sanger and racists who would be proud of its development as a weapon of global war against the dark have nots.

In Brazil it has been reported that massive sterilization activities are orchestrated by BEMFAM, the Brazilian affiliate of the London-based International Planned Parenthood Federation. In addition, many private firms are getting rich destroying the people's future. Included in this are: Pathfinder Fund, the Johns Hopkins University Population Communications Services project, Family Health International, the John Snow “Enterprise” program, the Program for the Introduction and Adaptation of Contraceptive Technology (PIACT), and the Association for Voluntary Surgical Contraception. They are also operating in many Afrikan nations.

Brazil is attempting to fight back. USAID shipments of condoms were seized and held by customs for over a year and then taken as contraband. Brazilian officials have begun to raise objections to the level of population activities in their country. It was obvious to the Brazilian authorities that the level of U.S. population assistance had become “overwhelming and unnecessary.” The high sterilization rate was dangerous as the news of U.S. intentions to curb births in developing countries traveled.

In the 70's Afrikan leaders were against population control programs proposed by the developed nations, however to gain credits from the World Bank, IMF, etc. they had to liberalize their opposition. Couple this cowardly liberalism with neo-colonial heads of state, Afrika was placed under serious genocidal attack.

Many Afrikan nations refuse to make policy statements about the need for population control, thus avoiding this tactic being used against them. Nations like: Mozambique, Somalia, Angola, Chad, Congo, Gabon, Libya, Sudan, Namibia, Benin, Burkina Faso, Cote d'Ivoire, Guinee, Mali, Mauritania and Togo are among them. And in others, there are strict rules that make such statements unenforceable by Western governments and their private intermediaries; sterilization, for example, is a criminal offense in Ethiopia, according to a study of national policies done by the UN several years ago. Sadly, the action of Brazil's legislature is an example of an effective response that comes too late. Already about 25 million Brazilian women have been victimized. At the same time the enemy has stepped up their genocidal activities. From the United Nations Database we get this report:

*In Nigeria, Pathfinder has an even larger number of current activities, including the training of medical personnel to perform birth control procedures in just about every state, as well as projects to “improve knowledge, attitude and practice of family planning” among both rural and urban women. It funneled approximately \$2 million from USAID into a national family planning campaign in Zimbabwe between 1987 and 1990, and has contributed large amounts of money to similar projects in Kenya and Tanzania, with smaller activities in several other African nations. The Association for Voluntary Surgical Contraception (formerly Assn. for Voluntary Sterilization) conducts activities primarily to promote methods that cause permanent infertility. It has US \$80 million in AID contracts, with numerous activities both in Brazil and Nigeria; it has made several recent payments to universities, hospitals and family planning associations in Ghana, Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia, Zimbabwe, Rwanda, Malawi, Burundi, Zaire, Mali, Senegal, and Sierra Leone. The PIACT program funds publications and media projects, as well as contraceptive distribution networks in Brazil. It conducts similar activities in about a dozen African states.*
