### **Destruction of Black Civilization** **by: Chancellor Williams**

I believe this is the first history book we should read. It deals with: what we lost, how we lost our civilizations, what he calls "The Afrikan Constitution," that should be a corner stone to the new "Revolutionary Pan-Afrikan Ideology" that we must forge together. He also reveals the role of Arabs in the "Destruction of Black Civilization" and how Islam was introduced to Afrika.

### **The Blackman of the Nile and His Family** **By: Dr. Josef Ben-Jochannon**

### **Philosophies and Opinions of Marcus Garvey**

This work is both an historical and a political document of immense importance. As a historical offering it puts you in the heart of the Universal Negro Improvement Association (UNIA). Pan-Afrikanism was the greatest response we have devised to rumble white supremacy and all its evil components. As a political tool, this book delivers a philosophical approach to reconstruction and supplies the foundation for the New Revolutionary Pan-Afrikan Ideology.
